2	WRM202: Water Resources Management	BSc Environment and Climate Studies; 3 years; RUB Credit 12. Equivalent to 6 ECTS.	University after CAC endorsement	The revised courses will be offered from January Spring semester 2021.
3	WRM101: Hydrology	BSc Environment and Climate Studies; 3 years; RUB Credit 12. Equivalent to 6 ECTS.	University after CAC endorsement	The revised courses will be offered from January Spring semester 2020.
4	CLM102: Climate Change Assessment and Mitigation.	BSc Environment and Climate Studies; 3 years; RUB Credit 12. Equivalent to 6 ECTS.	University after CAC endorsement	The revised courses will be offered from January Spring semester 2020.

The initial approval was also approved by the program committee meeting on July 2019 and subsequently by College Academic Committee on October 2019. After the completion of the review, the modules/courses were submitted to the Office of the Vice Chancellor and were then approved on dated 17 February 2021.

This is also to inform the team leader that in addition to the four courses/modules approved, there are more than 30 courses which benefitted from the SUNRAISE project facilitation. Also two new
